



GUEST DIRECTORY & CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

Welcome to Oelia Camping

For your safety, comfort and the pleasant stay of all our guests, please read the following information and campsite regulations carefully.

Upon arrival, all guests are required to present their identification documents (ID card or passport).

GUEST INFORMATION & SERVICES

Reception

During the high season, Reception operates 24 hours a day.

Check-in: 14:00–24:00

Check-out: 08:00–12:00

Our Reception staff are available to provide information and assistance throughout your stay.

Reservations & Online Payments

Direct reservations and electronic payments are available.

Wake-up Service

A wake-up service is available upon request. Please contact Reception.

Luggage Storage

Luggage storage is available to guests. Please contact Reception for assistance.

Luggage Transfer

A luggage transfer service within the campsite is available upon request.

Safe Deposit

A central safe deposit facility is available at Reception.

Tickets, Excursions & Events

Information and assistance regarding public transport tickets, excursions, local activities and events are available at Reception.

Tourist Information

Tourist information and relevant information material about the surrounding area and local attractions are available at Reception.

Guest Storage Facilities

Designated storage facilities are available for guests' use. Please contact Reception for further information.

First Aid

A designated First Aid room, equipped with First Aid equipment, is available within the campsite. In case of need or emergency, please contact Reception immediately.

BUNGALOWS

The following facilities and services are available in the campsite's bungalows.

Bungalow Facilities

Depending on the specific bungalow and its approved configuration, facilities include:

- Wardrobe with clothes hangers
- Hot water available 24 hours a day
- Blackout curtains
- Air conditioning for cooling and heating
- Internet access
- Safe deposit facility
- Television
- Insect repellent equipment
- Available parking space

Bathroom Facilities

Bungalow bathroom facilities include:

- Non-slip bath mat
- Shower cabin
- Hand soap
- Toilet paper
- Toilet brush
- Waste bin
- Drinking glass per bed
- Face towel and bath towel per bed
- Hair dryer
- Emergency bell

Bungalow Services

The following services are provided to guests staying in the bungalows:

- Daily linen change
- Daily change of bath towels
- Daily housekeeping
- Wake-up service upon request

FOOD & BEVERAGE SERVICES

Breakfast

Breakfast is served daily:

07:00–10:30

Lunch

Lunch is served daily:

13:00–18:30

Dinner

Dinner is served daily:

18:30–22:00

High chairs for infants and young children are available in the dining area.

COMMON FACILITIES

For the comfort and convenience of our guests, the campsite provides:

- Baby changing facilities
- Hair dryers in the men's and women's common sanitary facilities
- Iron and ironing board
- Non-slip entrance mats at the campsite buildings

Please follow the relevant signs throughout the campsite for the location of common facilities, services and guest areas.

CAMPSITE REGULATIONS

1. **Vehicle entry and exit:** 07:00–24:00.
2. The maximum speed limit for vehicles within the campsite is 5 km/h. Guests must comply with all road signs and directions within the campsite.
3. Vehicles may only be parked in designated parking areas.
4. **Washing vehicles is prohibited.**
5. **Pets are allowed**, provided that they are kept on a leash and under the supervision of their owners at all times. Pets are not allowed in the sea. Owners are required to collect and properly dispose of their pets' waste both inside and outside the campsite.

The campsite management reserves the right to request the removal of any pet that causes a disturbance through its behaviour or excessive barking. Failure to comply with these rules or with the instructions of the campsite staff may result in the owner being required to leave the campsite.
6. **Any unauthorised construction, alteration or installation of additional structures or materials is prohibited.** If any such alteration or intervention is identified and the camper refuses to comply with the instructions of the campsite staff, management reserves the right to require the camper to leave the campsite.
7. The permanent occupation or reservation of any part of the beach using umbrellas or other personal belongings is strictly prohibited.
8. **Quiet hours are 15:00–17:30 and 23:00–07:00.** During these hours, any activity causing disturbance, including loud conversations, loud music or organised festivities, is prohibited. At all other times, music and noise must be kept at reasonable levels so as not to disturb other guests.
9. The maximum electrical supply capacity per socket is 10 A / 2,200 W. Extension cables used for power supply must be durable, made of black rubber and comply with the stated IP specifications. Any unauthorised intervention in the electrical panels is strictly prohibited. All available electrical sockets are protected by automatic circuit-breakers.
10. Chemical toilets must only be cleaned and emptied in the designated areas. Emptying chemical toilets in any other area is prohibited.
11. **Disposal of any kind of waste on the beach or within the campsite is strictly prohibited.** Guests must use the designated waste disposal facilities and bins provided throughout the campsite.
12. Guests are solely responsible for the safety and security of their personal belongings. The company accepts no responsibility for loss, theft or damage to personal belongings. A central safe deposit facility is available at Reception.
13. **The company accepts no responsibility for damage caused by adverse weather conditions or other natural phenomena.**
14. Visitors are permitted within the campsite only with the prior approval of Reception. Visitors' vehicles are not permitted to enter the campsite.
15. **Lighting fires is strictly prohibited**, in accordance with the applicable Fire Service regulations. This prohibition applies both within the campsite and on the beach. The use of barbecue facilities is permitted only in the designated barbecue area and in accordance with campsite instructions and applicable fire safety requirements.
16. Guests must comply with all campsite signs, safety instructions and directions given by the campsite management and staff.

ACCEPTANCE OF REGULATIONS

All the above rules and conditions form an integral part of the campsite regulations and may only be amended in writing.

Any violation of these regulations, or failure to comply with instructions given by the campsite management or staff, may constitute grounds for termination of the guest's stay and immediate removal from the premises.

By entering and staying at the campsite, each camper and visitor unconditionally accepts all the above terms and regulations.
